Standard Chartered Bank v. United Republic of Tanzania (ICSID Case No. ARB/10/12) Procedural Order No. 6

The Tribunal has considered the request by Standard Chartered Bank ("SCB"), consented to by the United Republic of Tanzania ("GoT"), for a ten-day extension of time to file its Counter-Memorial on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents. The Tribunal grants SCB's request and hereby enters Procedural Order No. 6, modifying the procedural timetable, as set forth in the Minutes of the First Session of the Tribunal of 23 November 2011, SCB's letter dated 8 December 2011, and as previously amended by Procedural Order No. 4 of the Tribunal dated 7 June 2011, as follows:

- 1. The Claimant will file its Counter-Memorial on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents on 14 August 2011, rather than 4 August 2011;
- 2. The Respondent will file its Reply Memorial on Jurisdiction with reply testimony and documents on 6 October 2011, rather than 26 September 2011;
- 3. The Claimant will file its Rejoinder on Jurisdiction with witness testimony and documents on 1 December 2011, rather than 21 November 2011;
- 4. The Claimant and Respondent will notify each other of the name(s) of the witness(es) they wish to cross-examine on 5 December 2011, rather than 28 November 2011;
- 5. The rest of the procedural timetable, as set forth in the Minutes of the First Session of the Tribunal of 23 November 2011, SCB's letter dated 8 December 2011, and as previously amended by Procedural Order No. 4 of the Tribunal dated 7 June 2011, will remain unchanged.
